

# How to Find Cardiac Rehabilitation Programs in the United States Using the CDC Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke

**Step 1:** Go to the Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke at <https://www.cdc.gov/dhdsp/maps/atlas/index.htm>.

**Step 2:** Click on a state of interest.
